



## DID YOU KNOW?

Every \$1 in exports of grain adds an additional \$3.23 in business sales across the U.S.



The high protein of corn and corn coproducts, such as Dried Distillers Grains (DDGs), are an excellent source of energy



Dried corn silage can be added to feed rations to increase fiber content



Usage of WDGs can lower total pounds of feed fed per cow by up to two pounds per day



3% of U.S. corn exports are distributed to dairy



There are 9.3 million dairy cows in the U.S.
