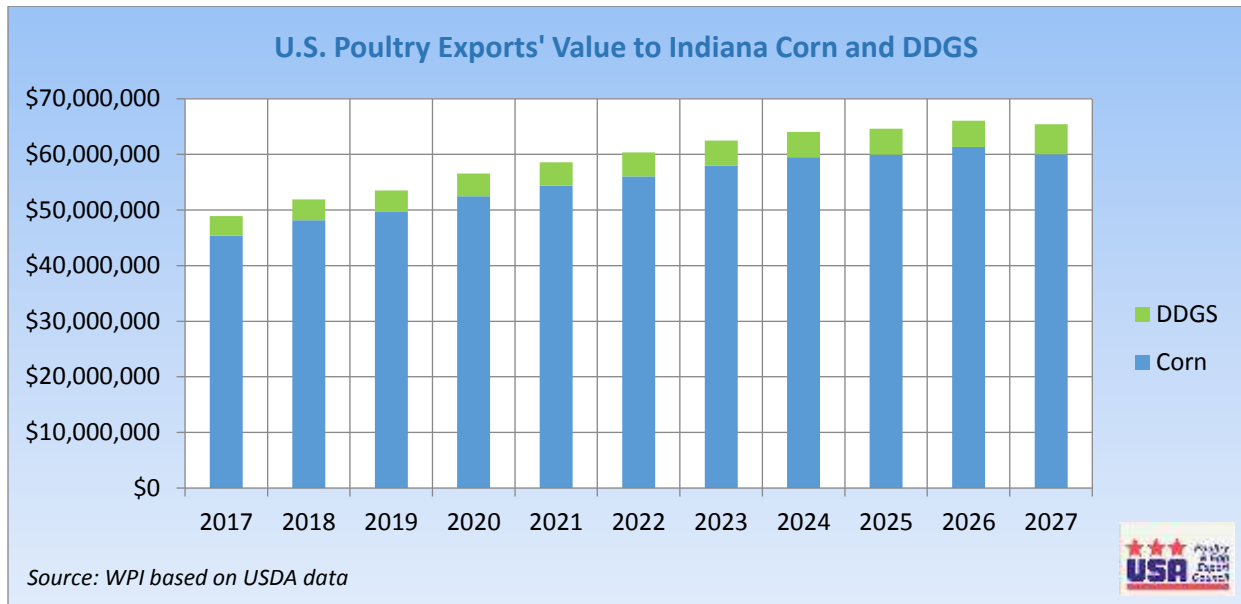


# U.S. Poultry and Indiana Corn: A Great Partnership

The value to Indiana corn and DDGS from 2017-2027 poultry exports will total approximately **\$652.4 million.**



## Broiler, turkey and egg exports in 2018-2027 will use:

- **176.88 million bushels** of Indiana corn.
- **456,635 tons** of Indiana DDGS.
- **230.61 million-bushel equivalent** of Indiana corn & DDGS.
- Further, **Indiana accounts for 45 percent of the U.S. duck flock.** Approximately 2.1 million bushels of corn were fed to ducks in Indiana in 2016.

## Indiana ranks:

- 1<sup>st</sup> in duck production.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> in egg production.
- 4<sup>th</sup> in turkey production

**58.87 million-bushel equivalent** of Indiana corn and DDGS were consumed in-state last year!

## Poultry Utilization of Corn

### Broiler, turkey and egg production in 2016/17:

- ✓ Used nearly *one-third* of all feed use of corn (1.66 billion bushels).
- ✓ Used another 3.58 million tons of DDGS; at 17 pounds per bushel, that's 421.6 million-bushel equivalent...
- ✓ For a total of 11.94 million acres of corn.

**Poultry exports added about 28 cents to the \$3.36/bushel price of corn in 2016/17.**
